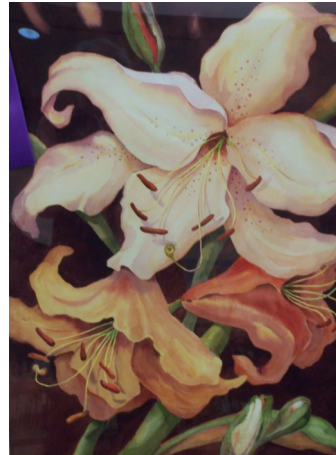

LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

About this time last year, I was writing the SCFD Grant request for 2010 and trying to think of a worthwhile project for our club to do. I have always loved to put on intergenerational-painting classes, so I submitted a Project Request to do some of these workshops.

Because Adams Cultural Council had put out an email stating that they needed organizations to submit for art projects in eastern Adams county, I submitted our proposal of putting on the workshops in Strasburg. Well, guess what? We got the grant. Now I have to figure out how many of you are willing to work with me on this worthwhile project.

The biggest commitment I am asking of you is to be willing to travel to Strasburg with me to teach painting to children, their parents and their grandparents. It is amazing to see how a child reacts when they are painting next to their Mom or grandmother and can produce a better painting than the adult because they have fewer inhibitions than the adults have. I am thinking of trying to have 3 or 4 workshops and then putting on an art show in the fall. We have been offered the gym at the Strasburg Recreation Center. I will be putting together a group to go on a fact-finding trip to Strasburg once the weather settles down later this spring. Please think about helping with this rewarding program that will bring the visual arts to those that don't always have the opportunities that we all do.

Oh, I am now working on the 2010 SCFD Grant so if you have some projects that you would like the Club to support, please let me know as soon as possible. I have a few ideas but would love to hear from you. Come to the meeting....We'll talk.

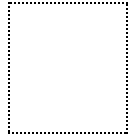
